

# Worshipful Company of Chartered Surveyors – IDBE Scholarship

The University of Cambridge Institute for Sustainability Leadership (CISL) and the Worshipful Company of Chartered Surveyors are delighted to announce the launch of a new scholarship for Interdisciplinary Design for the Built Environment (IDBE) Master's students, new for 2020 applications.

The Worshipful Company of Chartered Surveyors Scholarship is to support one student who can demonstrate their interest in, and commitment to, sustainability in the built environment.

## Scholarship amount

£5,000 per year (£10,000 in total over the 2-year course)

*The course fee for entry in 2020 is £21,450*

## Scholarship eligibility criteria

To be eligible, applicants must be a graduate with at least 3 years post-qualification experience in the built environment. In addition, applicants must:

- be working as a surveyor;
- demonstrate an interest in, and commitment to, sustainable built environments; and
- submit a full application to the IDBE Master's via the standard application process either before, or alongside, the scholarship application by the relevant deadlines.

The scholarship will be awarded to the successful applicant once s/he has received an offer of admission to the IDBE Master's and fulfilled any admission conditions set by the University.

## Application process

Application evaluation is principally based on the research proposal that is submitted in the Master of Studies application.

In addition, applicants must write a statement of no more than 500 words that comments on:

- why the candidate would like to be considered for the scholarship;
- how the candidate believes that attending the course will be of benefit to them and relevant to their career aspirations; and
- how the candidate hopes to use learning from the programme to benefit the wider profession (candidate may make reference to research proposal, if appropriate).

The Worshipful Company may ask the recipient to present their findings or share the results of their research.
